### Protect

# W

### Wash

Using a commercial washing machine rather than a domestic one allows you to wash at the high temperatures required to kill infections and will also cost you less in the long run.

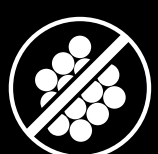
# S
